Guidelines for Selling Goods

- Medicine Hat and District Canada Day Society is not responsible or liable for claim from the participants.
- All items exhibited or sold must be locally made handicrafts (not large scale manufacture) and must be approved by the Hobby Craft Coordinator to avoid duplication or conflicts.
- Hazardous / harmful items are not permitted.
- Medicine Hat and District Canada Day Society conducts a Souvenir Booth as a fund raising project and the “Hobby Craft” is not to compete by selling the same items or imitations of the items.
- The participants are responsible to provide their own shelter (limited to 10’ by 10’ tent), table, and chairs.
- Electric power outlets are available upon request at the location. Portable generators are not permitted in the park.
- All participants must fill and sign the “Participant Contract” form and pay the fee by cheque payable to “Medicine Hat and District Canada Day Society”.
- Locations will be assigned at random for the participants.
- Subletting the assigned location to others will not be permitted.
